

UCSD Medical School Sign Posting and Exhibit Locations

Revised January 22, 2003

The posting of handbills on campus signage, other than on kiosks designed for this purpose, is prohibited. (See [*PPM 510-1, Section XII, Distribution, Posting and Exhibiting of Non-Commercial Literature*](#).) The UCSD School of Medicine has the following locations, some of which are under the supervision of the departments located at the sign areas, for the posting of materials:

- Glass display cases (4) at MTF-180, Office of Student Affairs (locked and under supervision of the OSA)
- Glass display cases (2) at MTF-182, SOM Admissions Office (locked and under supervision of Admissions Office)
- Concrete "pillar" which is signage stating "School of Medicine" between the Medical Teaching Facility and Club Med (south east of MTF)
- Glass display case on Club Med (locked and labeled "University Events")
- Basic Science Building Main Lobby, 3 glass cases, locked
- Basic Science Building, East and West walls outside of Garren Auditorium, 2 large glass cases each side and 2 large cork board sign areas next to glass cases on each wing. One (1) smaller glass case north of display area on east side of Garren
- Small display case outside of Tutorial Office door, BSB 1st floor, parallel to Garren
- Glass display case, west side of Garren, next to west stairway entrance
- Glass display case, SOM Dean's office, inside front entrance
- BSB, 2nd floor, corkboards outside of Liebow Auditorium on west and east sides

Additionally, the Office of Student Affairs has used the second floor banisters of the MTF (facing south to parking lot) to display banners welcoming and/or congratulating medical students. This "display" area is not an official sign or display case location but may fall under PPM 430 and 510 of temporary event signage. All other areas on the medical school campus such as pillars, sides of buildings, entrance doors, gates, stairwells and campus directory cases are not considered sanctioned display areas according to campus policy PPM 510-1.
