Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers Initial Course

This is a 6-hour course for the licensed healthcare provider who does not have a current CPR card or has let their card lapse. This course is ideal for EMTs, paramedics, nurses, medical assistants, healthcare students, or anyone working in a healthcare setting. The course includes recognition of heart attack signs and symptoms, stroke signs and symptoms, evaluation and risk factor assessment. There is significant manikin practice for Adult, Child, and Infant CPR as well as two-rescuer CPR techniques. Rescue breathing Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) practice, and airway obstruction removal techniques are included.

Upon successful completion of the course, written exam, and skill check off, each student will receive a course completion card which is valid for 2 years.

Heartsaver CPR, AED, and First Aid
