

## Summary of Skills Check List – Cardiovascular Exam

1.  Wash hands
2.  Gown and drape appropriately
3.  Inspect precordium
4.  Palpation of RV and LV; Determination of PMI

### Auscultation

5.  Elevate head of table to ~ 30°
6.  S1 and S2 in 4 valvular areas w/diaphragm
7.  Try to identify physiologic splitting S2
8.  Assess for murmurs
9.  Assess for extra heart sounds (S3, S4) w/bell over LV

### Carotid artery

10.  Palpation
11.  Auscultation

### Internal Jugular Vein

12.  Determine jugular venous pressure

### Lower Extremities

13.  General lower extremity observation

### Assess femoral area (you don't have to do this on fellow students)

14.  Palpation for nodes (**\*Special Test**)
15.  Femoral pulse (**\*Special Test**)
16.  Auscultation femoral artery (**\*Special Test**)

### Assess knees (non-mechanical exam)

17.  Color, swelling
18.  Palpate popliteal artery pulse (**\*Special Test**)

### Assess ankles and feet for:

19.  Color; Temperature; Capillary refill
20.  Check for edema
21.  Observe for any skin breakdown, ulcerations (including between toes, soles)

### Pulses

22.  Palpate dorsalis pedis artery
23.  Palpate posterior tibial artery

24.  Wash hands

**\*Special Test:** Not done on routine exam – Reserved for specific clinical situations
