

Summary of Skills – Eye Exam

- Wash hands
- Observe external eye structures (lids, sclera, pupil, iris, conjunctiva)
- Visual acuity (hand-held card or Snellen - CN 2)
- Visual fields (confrontation – CN 2)
- Extra-ocular movements (CN 3, 4, & 6)
- Corneal reflex, using wisp of cotton pulled from a q-tip (at least describe & demo this)

Using the Ophthalmoscope:

- Examine external eye structures (lids, sclera, pupil, iris, conjunctiva)
- Check pupillary response to light – direct and consensual (CN 2 & 3)
- Red reflex
- Retinal exam – identifying:
 - Optic disc, arteries, veins, color of retina, and macular area.
- Wash hands
