	3. Measure pulse in radial artery, noting: rate, rhythm and volume
	4. Measure blood pressure, both arms (for practice), using stethoscope
	5. Confirm by measuring systolic blood pressure by palpation *(special test)
	6. Measure blood pressure and pulse after positional changes (orthostatic) *(specia Test: if concerns about dizziness that's BP mediated, volume status)
	7. Measure respiratory rate
	8. Examine hands, nails, fingers
	9. Wash hands
*Special Test: Not done on routine exam – Reserved for specific clinical situations
